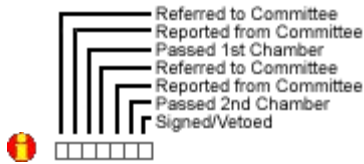

| HB 584  | Cookson, Steve(R) | Requires any statewide athletic organization with a public school district as a member to report to the joint committee on education during the legislative interim. Last Action: 1-12-17 H Read second time |
| HB 642  | Kelly, Hannah(R) | Prohibits public institutions of higher learning from discriminating against a religious student organization or denying a religious student association any benefit available to any other student association. Last Action: 3- 7-17 H Public hearing completed |
| HB 677  | Rowland, Lyle(R) | Allows a school district to use a calendar based on hours of attendance rather than hours and days of attendance, if the minimum number of hours is at least 1,044 hours of actual pupil attendance.
